Luke 4:18 (NKJV) - “The Spirit of the LORD *is* upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to *the* poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to *the* captives And recovery of sight to *the* blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;

Through MANNA, we are doing all of these! These children and families are poor! Many of them have been heartbroken through persecution/history in their nation. Without out help, they would be further victimized in sex trafficking and oppression.

Lessons from some little brothers and sisters:

1. GIVE THANKS FOR WHAT YOU HAVE BEEN GIVEN. (PRO PRESENTER SLIDE
BULLETIN OUTLINE)

Luke 17:12-17 (NLT) - ¹² As he entered a village there, ten men with leprosy stood at a distance, ¹³ crying out, “Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!” ¹⁴ He looked at them and said, “Go show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were cleansed of their leprosy. ¹⁵ One of them, when he saw that he was healed, came back to Jesus, shouting, “Praise God!” ¹⁶ He fell to the ground at Jesus’ feet, thanking him for what

he had done. This man was a Samaritan. ¹⁷ Jesus asked, “Didn’t I heal ten men? Where are the other nine?”

2. **LEND** A **HAND** TO **SERVE** THOSE AROUND YOU. *(PRO PRESENTER SLIDE BULLETIN OUTLINE)*

John 13:14-15 (NLT) - ¹⁴ And since I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you ought to wash each other’s feet. ¹⁵ I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you.

3. **YOU DON’T HAVE TO HAVE A LOT TO GIVE** A LOT. *(PRO PRESENTER SLIDE BULLETIN OUTLINE)*

Luke 21:1-4 (NLT) - While Jesus was in the Temple, he watched the rich people dropping their gifts in the collection box. ² Then a poor widow came by and dropped in two small coins. ³ “I tell you the truth,” Jesus said, “this poor widow has given more than all the rest of them. ⁴ For they have given a tiny part of their surplus, but she, poor as she is, has given everything she has.”
