John 2:1-11
Small Group Study Notes

- ❖ What are some of the biblical cautions regarding alcoholic beverages?
- ❖ Have you had challenges in your life or in your family due to alcohol?
- ❖ How do you need to balance your personal freedom (in any area) with sensitivity to stumbling blocks for others?

Read John 2:1-2

- Why do you think Jesus was at this wedding?
- How are you involved in your community?
- Are there areas that you can become more active in supporting your community?

Read John 2:3-5

- How do you see the role of Jesus and Mary in this passage?
- What do you think Mary was feeling in adjusting to this new role?
- Do you have relationships that have changed recently? How is that impacting you?
- Jesus had some boundaries, but also showed some flexibility. Do you have more trouble with setting needed boundaries or with being flexible when needed?
- Is it harder for you to step up or sit and wait until time to act? Why?

Read John 2:6-11

- What do you think this miracle was like for the panicked family at the wedding?
- What about the disciples and Mary as they watched this happen?
- The servants had to fill the jars with water. What would have happened if they laughed at the idea and did nothing? Discuss the correlation between God working and our participating.
- Can you relate to some area in your life where Jesus took your mundane (water) and turned it into something miraculous (wine)?

Close:

- Spend some time thanking God together for where He has been at work in your life. Share where you need to grow, based on this passage of Scripture.
