1. **READ John 19:1-27**

3. What is the significance of the inscription, in three languages, above the cross?
4. What is significant about the women who were at the crucifixion?
5. What difference does it make to know that Jesus was not just a victim of an unfair trial and execution, but that his death was a part of HIS PLAN to redeem his people...that none of this came as a surprise to him?
6. How could you describe the meaning of "Jesus as Passover Lamb" to a friend of yours who doesn't know much about the Bible?
7. Think about events in your personal life, (or in the world) in light of Jesus' suffering on the cross. How are they related to one another?
