This summer for 6 weeks we will be offering large group sessions from our very own counseling staff. These sessions will be an in-depth look at our new sermon series The Monsters Within Us.

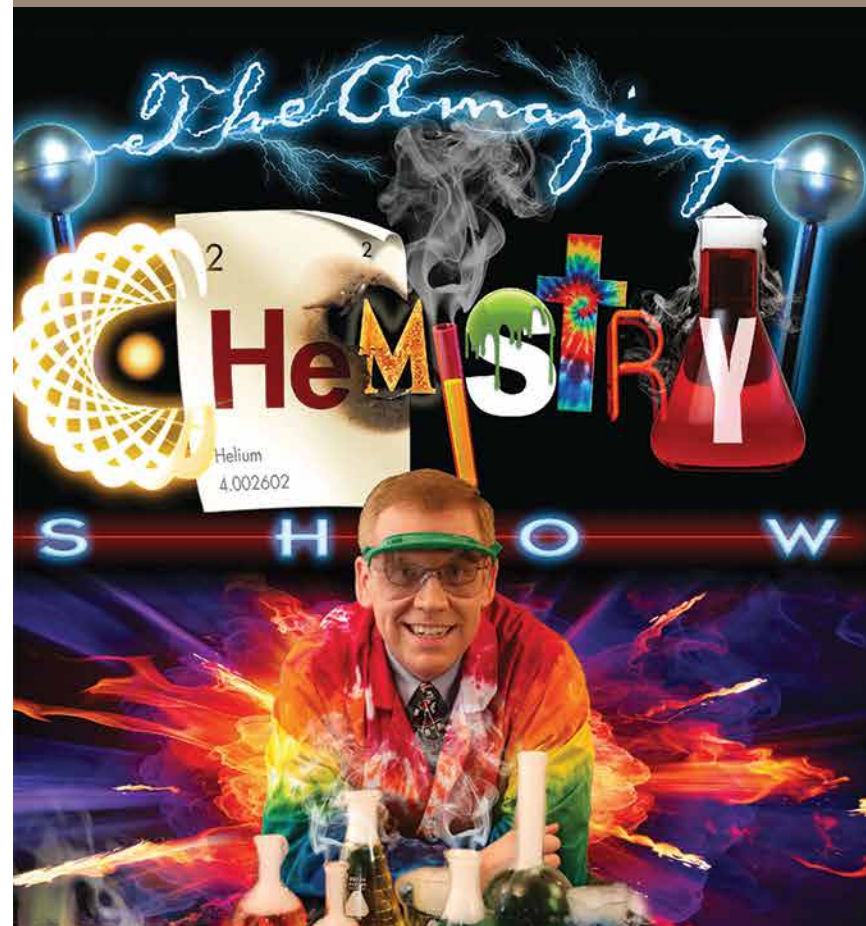
