## Understanding Our Assignment

##### b) Baptizing

- Who should be baptized? When? What method?
- What is the purpose of baptism?

##### c) Teaching

- What might this involve? (words and actions)
- What is the new believers to be taught?

#### 3) He promises His presence.

- How does Jesus identify Himself?
- This is a two-sided promise...Discuss.

#### CLOSE:

- How is a disciple maker different then a church attendee?
- What would it look like to give access to someone into your life?
- Are you willing to invest time in someone?
- Do you have the "Disciple One" tool?
  - Are you willing to accept the task? Pray, ask God to show you who you can disciple.
  - Look for someone spiritually hungry.
