My family has personally benefited from your service. A hostile employee attacked my dad in 1997 and stabbed him repeatedly. Had the police not arrived when they did, we are not sure dad would have made it. He was airlifted to Richland Memorial where a team of medical professionals went to work. God used First Responders to save my dad's life. Last year many of us watched the news as you rescued people in the "1000 year flood." We thank you for being willing to put yourself in harms way and provide safety to our citizens on a daily basis. We are privileged to have the Highway Patrol Honor Guard with us this morning. They will present the colors at the opening of our Service, Linda MacDonald will play taps and Ed Wilkes will play "Amazing Grace" on the bagpipes. We encourage you to visit with our First Responders out in the parking lot at 11:40 AM. Many of them have brought some of their resources to share with you. We will form a human prayer chain around them at 12 and have a word of prayer. First Responders and their families are invited to a barbecue dinner in the Fellowship Hall at 12:15.

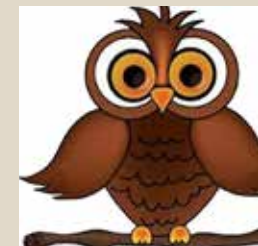
