

Welcome to our outdoor baptism. We are celebrating with those who have placed their faith in Jesus Christ. Baptism is not a part of salvation but a picture of salvation. A person stands in the water, is immersed under the water and comes up out of the water... picturing our salvation or the Gospel message; Jesus was nailed to the cross, buried in the tomb and He rose from the dead (1 Corinthians 15:3 & 4). The very act of baptism is how we announce/proclaim to others that we have trusted in Jesus as our Lord and Savior. Scripture tells us that we are not to be ashamed of Christ. Mark 8:38 says: "if anyone is ashamed of me and my message in these adulterous and sinful days, the Son of Man will be ashamed of that person when He returns in the glory of His Father with the holy angels." Celebrate with your brothers and sisters in Christ. Right before we baptize, after the short Gospel message, we will give those who have never placed their faith in Jesus Christ an opportunity to meet us at the cross (located at the floor of the amphitheater) and take this important step of faith today. First comes the cross (salvation) and then baptism (obedience).

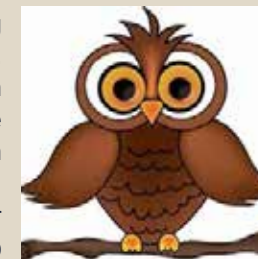
