
Creation Station - Wednesday Night

Thailand Trip

Please pray for our success with this trip. To engage the nations for the Glory of God. This week they will be in a fishing village that was decimated by the Boxing Day Tsunami of 2004. Roughly 75% of human life was lost that day. Fifteen years later and the village is still recovering. While there in Baan NamKem, we will be teaching some geography and conversational English to the Burmese refugees in the area, serving the students by reading with them in English, and building a sustainable vegetable garden and pouring concrete posts for a walkway between two of their buildings. We will also have the opportunity one of the days to enter into a Thai school with primarily Buddhist children to do a cultural exchange where we teach them about Thanksgiving holiday from a Christian perspective. We will get to share our faith with them that day as we count our blessings and give thanks to God for His provision.

Missionary Highlight

Our missionary highlight is Jason Goh. Jason is the director of the New Light CDC or Community Development Center, Baan Namkem (CDC). He hopes the New Light CDC will play a part in promoting the value of education, providing youth with more career choices, and provide a place for the villagers to build relationships through social events and activities. The 2004 tsunami brought Jason to Nam Kem. What started out as a relief mission later turned into a realization of the immense opportunities to contribute to the overall development of the village.


